### Reading Group Guide

1. What was unique about the setting of the book and how did it enhance or take away from the story?
2. Location can have great emotional significance, bringing us back to a memory or helping us become someone new. What does Antler Creek represent for each of the characters? Is there a place in the world that is meaningful for you in the same way?
3. How did you feel about the choice Liz made to chase her dream? What would you have done differently?
4. What specific themes did the author emphasize throughout the novel? What do you think she is trying to get across to the reader?
5. At what point do you think Liz realized there was something between her and Matt?
6. Do the characters seem real and believable? Can you relate to their predicaments? To what extent do they remind you of yourself or someone you know?
7. What Christmas celebration scene did you find the most charming, and how does it compare to your favorite holiday memories?
8. Have you ever taken a big risk? How did you grow from that experience? What would you do differently?
9. Which character did you most easily relate to? How are you similar? Different?
10. Who would you cast to play each character in a movie adaptation of *Christmas Angels*? Why?
